Classes may take place

and

can range from 3 hours every week for 6-8 weeks or 6 hours for 1, 2, or 3-day workshops.

Hourly Rate: \$35/hour 6-10 students; \$40/hour 11-15 students and \$45/hour 16-20 students

Minimum Number of Participants: 6
Maximum Number of Participants: 15

Instructors must have proof of fingerprint and background clearance, and are expected to assist with participant evaluation surveys and studio clean-up after each class.

Proposals must include resume with teaching experience, proposed class description, information worksheet and 6 samples of work (jpg)*.

*Labeling and Presentation of Digital Images

- Each image must be 600 dpi/resolution and at least 6" wide
- Each image file must be in jpg format
- The image should not exceed 5MB
- Label your jpg files "01-06" followed by your last name. For example, Joe Smith's image files would be: 01Smith.jpg, 02Smith.jpg, etc.
- Number the image file names in the order you would like them viewed. Make sure these numbers correspond to your Image Description Sheet
- The CD should only include images you are submitting as a part of your application.
- Write your name, address, and phone number on your CD and CD case.

Image Description Sheet

- Make sure your name is on the Image Description Sheet
- List should be in numerical order and correspond to the numbers on the digital files as you have ordered them.
- Each image should include the following information: title, medium, date completed and dimension (H"xW"xD"). You may want to include a brief explanation of unusual or complex techniques.
