TIZIANO VECELLI

From 1516 until his death in 1576, Tiziano Vecelli or Tiziano Vecellio (known in English as Titian) was the undisputed master of Venetian painting. He is to color (colorito) what Michelangelo is to drawing and sculpture (disegno).

This lecture will survey his splendid paintings and introduce examples of those by his followers, Veronese and Tintoretto, and address his later influence on Rubens and Velasquez.

Portraits as we know them today appeared in the early 14th century, then became popular with the Italian Renaissance. After artists established their status within a more open society, Rembrandt elevated self-portraits to an art form, exploring the complexities of an artist's psych - establishing a precedent that would later be followed by many (Goya, Delacroix, Degas, Van Gogh, Gauguin come to mind).
