# NATURE'S KINGDOM

An Exhibition Showcasing All the Landscapes, Animals & Insects That Nature Has to Offer

August 28 - October 5, 2019

- Artist must be an Arizona resident at least 18 years old.
- Work must be original.
- Work cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 2 feet in width
- Work cannot exceed 150 lbs (pedestal display) or 50 lbs (hanging display)
- Work accepted for the exhibition to be displayed on wall must be ready to hang with a wire on back, taut, approximately 1/3 of the way from the top so that wire does not show or pull above frame when hung. No sawtooth hangers.
- Canvases should be wrapped or framed without glass. All work accepted must arrive ready to hang with wire. Art framed under glass must use museum-quality, plexiglass or single-strength glass (no non-glare). Framed work should not weigh more than 50 lbs.

# Additional Information

All artwork will be insured by Shemer Art Center, for the duration of the exhibit. Prior arrangements for the installation of large-scale sculpture must be made in advance and approved by the Executive Director.
