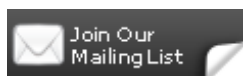

Greetings!

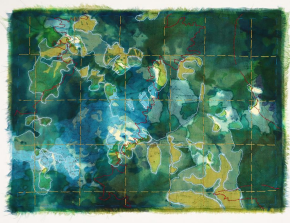

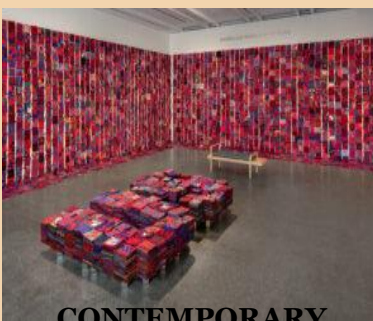
