

ABOUT THE JUROR

Jim Waid is an internationally known artist whose large, colorful, abstract works of art showcase the magnificence of Arizona. He moved to Arizona in 1968 and has lived and worked in Tucson ever since. He received a bachelor's degree in fine arts from the University of New Mexico and a master's degree in fine arts from the University of Arizona. From 1971-1980 he taught art at Pima Community College and has been a visiting artist at the University of Idaho, Arizona State University, and the University of Texas at San Antonio. In 1985 he received a National Endowment for the Visual Arts Fellowship, in 2013 Jim received the 2013 Governor's Arts Award for Individual Artist in recognition of his impact on the arts in Arizona. In 2016, JIM WAID PAINTINGS, a hard-back coffee-table-style book was published, covering 50 years of Jim's artistry. In 2017 he received the Inaugural Ambassador's Circle Lifetime Achievement Award from the Tucson Museum of Art and he was recognized as a Shemer Honors honoree by the Shemer Art Center. He is represented by the Bentley Gallery in Phoenix, and the William Havu Gallery in Denver.

ABOUT THE EXHIBITION

The Shemer Art Center is now accepting entries for this exhibition, to be juried by Tucson, Arizona-based artist Jim Waid. Works selected will be created by Arizona artists who are inspired by gardens, small creatures and our natural environment. Entries should reflect the theme of the exhibition and include birds, bugs and botanicals of all kinds and varieties. Selected works will be created from a range of media, including but not limited to, painting, drawing, printmaking, photography, ceramics, wood, metal, fiber, and glass. Works will be unique in perspective and offer authentic viewpoints. Artwork can be realistic or abstract and all artwork must be original.

SUBMISSION GUIDELINES

- Artists are asked to submit up to three artworks in digital format for the jury process.
- Artists may include one detail image for each entry if needed.
- Signature or artist's name must be cropped out or removed from the image!
- Images must be jpg format and 300 dpi
- Images should be no greater than six (6) inches on the longest side and approx. 1MB in size.
- Each image submitted should be labeled in this format:

EXHIBITION DETAILS

- Artist must be an Arizona resident at least 18 years old.
- Artwork must be original.
- Artwork cannot exceed 5 feet in height, 4 feet in width.
- Artwork cannot exceed 100 lbs (pedestal display) or 50 lbs (hanging display).
- Larger, more complex artworks will require installation assistance by the artist.
- Artwork accepted for hanging must be ready to hang with a wire on back, taut, approximately 1/3 of the way from the top so that wire does not show or pull above frame when hung. Entries without wire will not be accepted.
- Canvases should be wrapped or framed without glass. Art framed under glass must use museum-quality, plexiglass or single-strength glass (no non-glare). Framed work should not weigh more than 50 lbs.
- All artwork submitted must have been created within the last three years and cannot have been previously included in an exhibition at the Shemer Art Center.

SALES

Artists who sell their work should expect to receive 70% of the sale price, with 30% retained by the Shemer Art Center. All works are encouraged to be available for purchase. However, if works are not available for sale, please indicate NFS (not for sale) on your entry.

- assist with installation as needed.

Artist also then agrees to submit (upon acceptance):

- a digital photograph of artist.
- a short biography (100 words or less in paragraph form).

ADDITIONAL INFORMATION

All artwork will be insured by Shemer Art Center for the duration of the exhibit. Prior arrangements for the installation of large-scale sculpture must be made in advance and approved by the Executive Director.
