Materials List *suggested list, to be discussed on first day of class*

Below is a list of suggested supplies that you may find useful. Please bring any supplies you already have to class. We will discuss supplies on the first day of class. Email suehunter7@cox.net if you have questions.

- Wood cradle board (optional)
 - You can order wood cradle boards from Amazon - six 10” x 10”, or four 11” x 14”, or one 18” x 24”
 - AZ Art Supply has many sizes of wood cradle boards
 - There will be a demonstration on preparing a wood cradle board with muslin and gesso during the first class, this will not be ready to paint on the first class so also bring another canvas to paint on the first day
- Medium weight muslin to fit the wood cradle boards (one yard is plenty to start) (Amazon-medium weight)
- Canvases - any size but small (10” x 10” or 11” x 14”) or Canvas board, Sourcetex or RayMar to start
- Medium to heavy bodied gesso
- Paper towels (blue paper towels recommended)
- Paints- You may choose to bring oils or acrylics. Some students like to use both but you do not have to purchase both for this class.
 - If you are painting with only acrylics, bring what you have
 - If using acrylic and oil you will only need a few basic colors for acrylic underpainting. Here are a few suggestions: Ultramarine Blue, Burnt Sienna, yellow, teal, green, rose, purple, and white
 - Suggested oils: Cad Yellow Medium, Cad Red Light, Quinacridone Rose, Alizarin Crimson, Dioxazine Violet, Yellow Ochre, Sap Green, White
- Gamsol for oils

- Palette: Several types available, many students like to use the plastic container with blue lid and palette paper or glass insert which is sold separately
- Water container and Gray Matters Paper Palette 16" x 20" (Amazon) for acrylics
- Hobby Lobby has their Master's Touch acrylics, oil, brushes, canvas and frames 40% off every other week.
- Palette knives
 - Flat palette knife (Hobby Lobby or Amazon)
 - Flexible joint knife, 4" or 6" (Ace or Amazon, Amazon difficult to tell if flexible)
 - Regular palette knife for mixing
 - Small palette knife for small spaces
