Materials List suggested list, to be discussed on first day of class

Below is a list of suggested supplies that you may find useful. Please bring any supplies you already have to class. We will discuss supplies on the first day of class. Email suehunter?@cox.net if you have questions.

- Canvas boards or stretched canvas several in 8" x 10", 9" x 12", 11" x 14".
- Paper towels (blue recommended)
- Palette knife

You may choose to bring oils or acrylics. Some students like to use both but you do not have to bring both to class.

FOR OILS:

- Suggested paint colors: Cadmium Yellow Light, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Sap Green, Titanium White, Transparent Red Iron Oxide (Bring any colors you like to use. You can add other colors later if you choose.)
- Odorless Mineral Spirits: I use Gamsol and a leakproof metal container or a glass jar with coil.
- Palette: Several types available, many students like to use the plastic container with blue lid and palette paper or glass insert which is sold separately



• Brushes: Brights or Filberts #6, #8, #10, Round #2 and Liner or Rigger #1 or #2 (Simply Simmons brand is inexpensive)

FOR ACRYLICS:

- Suggested paint colors: Cadmium Yellow, Cadmium Red Light, Alizarin Crimson, Ultramarine Blue, Sap or Hookers Green, Titanium White
- Palette: Sta-Wet Plastic palette with red lid, sponge, and paper (12" x 16") or plastic-coated paper plates
- Spray bottle and water container
- Brushes: Inexpensive (Simply Simmons) 1" flat, ½" flat, bright #6, round #2

(Some of these items, especially Simply Simmons brushes, **are only at Arizona Art Supply**, ask for student discount)
