Materials List *suggested list, to be discussed on first day of class*

- Sketchbook – made to be used with watercolor
 - I will be using the Strathmore Visual Journal 140 lb Watercolor – 9” x 12” and 44 pages
- Pencil and eraser
- Waterproof fine line pens
 - I will be using black Pigma Micron pens in .01, .03, .05, and .08 sizes
- Watercolor paints – only small quantities necessary
 - Colors: Quinacridone Gold, Burnt Umber, Manganese or Cerulean Blue, Orange, Permanent Rose or Opera Pink, Sap Green, Titanium White
 - A small set of watercolor pan paints will also do
- Brushes
 - #10 round and maybe #6 round
 - Rigger brush
 - 1” flat and 1/2” flat
- Tombow pens
 - N15, N79, N89, N95, and black
 - Can start with a set of six “gray tones” or purchase individually
