Materials List *suggested list, to be discussed on first day of class*

Please feel free to bring the watercolor supplies you normally use.

- Pencil
- Eraser
- Notebook for taking notes (preferably sketchbook)
- Small painting support - either a piece of cardboard or a plastic board (16" x 20")
- Paints: new gamboge or cadmium yellow, ultramarine blue or cobalt blue, vermilion or quinacridone rose to start
 - Tube colors are best
- Water container – small quart or pint size plastic bowl
- Paper towels
- Small spray bottle
- Brushes - synthetic brushes might be wanted such as Simply Simmons
 - 1" flat watercolor brush
 - #8 or #10 round watercolor brush
 - I will also have brushes you may try out and use in class
- Paper - practice paper and Arches or Strathmore watercolor paper will be provided
